EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2017-2018 ACT-tested freshmen (716) represents (26%) of student score reports received by your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students identified on National Student Clearinghouse enrolled data as full time. It is assumed that students for whom an enrollment status was not provided (i.e., blank) are full-time.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 21.6 (men = 21.9, women = 21.4). The national ACT composite for 2016-2017 high school graduates was 21.0.
